Forthcoming CPD opportunities for Primary Schools

MARRIAGE MATTERS led by Sally McElroy

This year the Archdiocese will be offering CPD on a cluster basis for Primary Schools with a strong focus on marriage in this year of the Synod on Marriage and Family Life. This will link to God's Loving Plan and its successful application in the class in P7.

CONSCIENCE MATTERS led by Patricia Carroll

There will also be an opportunity for schools to opt into CPD about the formation of conscience. This is weaved into the strands of faith in a progressive way throughout Primary school, but has particular importance in P3 where preparation takes place for the sacrament of reconciliation and in P6.

OPENING UP THE GOSPELS led by Patricia Carroll

This CPD will be available on a deanery basis at the request of head teachers with a focus on a particular Gospel used within a year group.

Opening up Mark for P5 teachers. This will focus on the core learning in the Gospel of Mark.
